

The Saint Clair Area Elementary/Middle School is enrolled in the Penn State PRO Wellness Healthy Champions Program for the 2020/2021 academic year. Our current score report provides valuable information about our school's health and wellness Star Status. Based on the information provided in the Healthy Champions enrollment School Wellness Assessment, we have successfully earned a 4 Star Healthy Champion Status for the 2020/2021 program year.

We are among 57% of over 630 enrolled Pennsylvania schools that have achieved a 4 Star Healthy Champion Status. Schools could obtain a maximum of five stars.
